Join us at the second Early Career and Doctoral Workshop on Comparative Social and Public Policy. This workshop, organised by doctoral researchers from the Department of Political and Social Sciences at Pompeu Fabra University (UPF), is an opportunity for young scholars to connect and share insights into their research.

About the Doctoral Workshop

The workshop seeks to foster collaboration and insightful discussions among doctoral, early career researchers and established scholars. Abstracts addressing the broad field of comparative social policy and social-oriented public policy research are invited. The workshop is open to quantitative and qualitative research approaches from a variety of theoretical perspectives, such as institutionalism, political economy, comparative politics, policy analysis and political sociology. We welcome submissions across a wide range of topics related to social protection and labour market policies, including areas of health, migration, and family, among others. Comparative analysis is preferable although single case studies with a comparative relevance are also welcome.

This is an in-person two-day event at Universitat Pompeu Fabra, Barcelona. Each session features presentations, comments from invited senior discussants, and collective discussions. Selected participants are required to submit a draft paper, prepare a 20-min presentation, and review papers from their fellow participants.

There is no funding provided for travel and accommodation, but coffee break and lunch will be provided for participants.

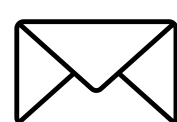
